ADOPTED AMENDMENT TO THE DECLARATION OF CONDOMINIUM OF LAKE PLACE, A CONDOMINIUM

Amendment to Article 17.2 of the Declaration of Condominium, to delete the present language and add new language as follows:

- Pets. Except for small domestic birds or fish, each Unit Owner (regardless of the number of joint owners) may maintain one (1) household pet in his Unit, to be limited to a domestic cat or one (1) other household pet (as defined by the Association), provided they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose and so not become a nuisance or annoyance to neighbors. Any dog which is properly being kept within the community as of the effective date of this provision may continue to be kept. Thereafter, no dogs of any type whatsoever may be kept or harbored upon the Condominium Property....
- Except for small domestic birds, or fish, 17.2 Pets. (regardless of household maintain one Owners). be limited to domestic dogs not to exceed domestic cats. pounds, twenty birds, fish tank not to exceed one kept. bred, or provided they are not commercial purpose and do for become a nuisance or annoyance to neighbors. Owners must pick up all solid wastes of their pets and dispose of such waste appropriately. All pets. including cats, must be leashed at all times when outside the Unit. Pets may not be kept in a Limited Common Element. Without limiting the generality of Section 18 hereof, violation of the provisions of this paragraph shall entitle the Association to all of its rights and remedies. including, but not limited to, the right to fine Unit Owners (as provided in this Declaration or the Bylaws) and/or to require any pet to be permanently removed from the Condominium Property. No one other than a Unit Owner is permitted to keep any pets.
